



DRESS CODE

On the Main Course

- Recognised golfing attire is required at all times
This includes hoodies and jogging bottoms from recognised golfing brands
- Men's Shirts must have a short sleeve as a minimum requirement
- Ladies may wear sleeveless shirts with a collar
- Shorts may be worn but they must be tailored and with socks of any colour
- Golf shoes and trainers are permitted.
- Work boots, dress shoes or sandals/sliders are NOT permitted
- Jeans, tracksuits, numbered polo or any football shirts are NOT permitted

All staff have the authority to decide on the appropriate level of dress

The dress code is for the benefit of all golfers, and we request that all golfers wear the appropriate attire. The result of wearing the incorrect attire may lead to you not being allowed on to the golf course.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

On the Main Course

- Arrive on the 1st tee at least 10 minutes prior to your tee time with your valid green fee receipt
- Repair pitchmarks and replace divots
- Rake bunkers after use
- Keep up with the pace of play of the group in front
- If you are a 2-Ball, you may be required to pair up with other players
